

Bounded as follows beginning at a heap of stones at the northerly corner of the premises then running south about three deg: west about one hundred and twenty eight rods by Samuel Fair banks land to a heap of stones on a rock then turning and running west ^{about} eight deg: south about twenty eight rods to a heap of stones bounded by Thomas Taft's Land then turning and running southwardly six rod and a quarter of a rod to a heap of stones bounding Easterly by ^{to} said Taft's land to land I have conveyed to my son Samuel Cragin then turning and running west about one deg: north about fifty two rods to a heap of stones at the north end of a pair of bars by the stone wall then turning and running north about Eighteen deg: East about Twenty nine rods as the wall now stands then running north twenty five deg: East ~~sixteen~~ rods to a heap of stones then the same point last mentioned sixteen rods to a heap of stones then north fifteen deg: west four rods and three quarters of a rod to a heap of stones by the wall then running west about Fifteen deg: South as the wall now stands to a heap of stones by the road near the grantor's dwelling house then crossing the road and running west two deg: south five rod and a half to a heap of stones by the bars then running west about 43 deg: north five rods and a half to the end of a wall then west eight deg: north twelve rods and a half to a turn in the wall then north five deg: west eighteen rods to a turn in the wall then west 21 deg: north ten rods and a half then south about 35 deg: west six rods then west 12 deg: south ten rods and a half then west five deg: north nine rods to a turn in the fence or wall then north 16 deg: East thirteen rods then north 12 deg: west five rod to a heap of stones by the fence to Darius Daniels Land all the lines above mentioned from Thos. Taft's Land are bounded by said Samuel Cragin's land then turning and running northeastly about forty two rods to a heap of stones bounding northwesterly by said Darius Daniels Land then turning Eastwardly and bounding northerly by Samuel Fair banks land about sixty eight rods to the road then bounded on said road to the first mentioned boundaries it being a various line and about sixty rods in
