Whereas Oliver Farrington of Wrentham in the County of Norfolk Gentleman by the consideration of our Justice of our Court of Common Pleas holden at Worcester within and for our County of Worcester aforesaid on Monday next preceeding the fourth Tuesday of March last recovered Judgment against Nathan Aldrich of Cumberland in the County of Providence and State of Rhode Island and Providence Plantations German for the sum of one hundred and Ninety Nine dollars & eleven cents damage and twelve dollars and forty eight cents costs of suit as to us appears of record wherof Execution remain to be done we command you therefore that of the goods, chattels or lands of the said Nathan within your Precinct you cause to be paid and satisfied unto the said Oliver at the Value thereof in money the aforesaid sum being two hundred and eleven dollars and fifty nine cents in the whole with twenty five cents more for this writ & thereof also to satisfy yourself for your own fees and for want of goods, chattels or lands of the said Nathan to be by him shown unto you or found within your Precinct to the acceptance of the said Oliver to satisfy the sum aforesaid we command you to take the body of the said Nathan and him commit unto our goal in Worcester in our County of Worcester aforesaid and detain in your custody within our said Goal untill he pay the full sum above mentioned with your fees or that he be discharged by the said Oliver the Creditor or otherwise by order of Law his officers fail not and make return of this writ with your doings therein into our said Court of common pleas to be holden at Worcester within our County of Worcester aforesaid upon the Monday next preceeding the second Tuesday of June next witness Joseph Dorr Esq. at Worcester the third day of April Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and one
