Worcester April 20th 1801 at the direction of the creditor I laid the within Execution upon ^{about} three fourths of an acre of land and a part of a dwelling house that stands thereon bounded as follows (to wit) beginning at the southwest corner of the premises by the road leading to George Aldrich thence bounding on said road as far as the line extends that Nathan Aldrich purchased of Chad Mason thence running easterly bounding on Josiah Hall's land about four rods to the fence now stand, thence fourthly bounding on said Hall's land about ten rods to a stake & stones by an apple tree near the fence thence running southerly about fourteen rods a straight line to stake and stones by the turnpike road thence running westerly on said road to the first corner and bound, and all of said land excepting a privilege in the front yard fourth of the house to the owners and one part of the other part of said house which I have not hereafter be described to lay necessary fire wood in and to pass and repass to said road together with the east end of said house beginning at the center of the front door then running through the center of the chimney through the house together with all the garret over the west end of the house with one half of the cellar under the east end of the said house being the fourth side of the cellar to the center of said cellar and have caused the same to be set off by me & bound and said land and house to be appraised by three sufficient freeholders (viz) Adams Chapin chosen by the creditor Luke Kelly chosen by the debtor Benjamin Godfrey by my self who have upon their oaths appraised the above described land and house at the value of two hundred and twenty four dollars and ninety one cents in full satisfaction of the within Execution and cost of laying the cost of laying being thirteen dollars & seven cents I have delivered possession to the creditor —

Mendon April 20th 1801 we the subscribers being sworn as above mentioned have upon our oaths appraised the above described land & house to be worth two hundred & twenty four dollars and ninety one cents and no more —
