To have and to hold the same to the said John Butler his heirs and assigns to him and their executors and administrators forever and I do covenant with the said John Butler his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises that they are free of all incumbrances and that I will warrant and defend the same to the said John Butler his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third Day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and five —
