do hereby acknowledge have remised released and forever quit-
claimed and do for ourselves and our heirs by these presents remise
release and forever quitclaim unto the said Samuel Aborn
his heirs and assigns all our right title and interest in and unto
the following tracts of lands being the whole of the real estate of
which David Metcalf late of Mendon in said County of Worcester
did seized to wit a certain tract or parcel of land situated in Mendon
aforesaid containing by estimation fifty Acres be the same more or
less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a heap of stones
on the north side of the Hartford road so called being a corner of
David Fales house thence running easterly bounding on said
road about twenty five rods to a town road leading to Milford
thence bounding easterly on said Milford road about ninety six
rods to the eight rod road so called thence bounding on said eight rod
road so called about sixteen rods the land belonging to the Widow
Catherine Smith a heap of stones being the corner bound thence
west about 33° South one hundred and eight rods to a heap of stone
thence north 7 1/2 west ten rods to a heap of stone thence west 55° south
twenty rods to a town road leading from George Aldrich's to
Mendon Town the three last mentioned lines are bound northerly
by land of the said Catherine Smith thence Southerly bounding on
