hundred and ninety dollars paid me by Ebenezer Cheeney of  
Barre in said County Blacksmith, the Receipt whereof I do hereby  
acknowledge, do hereby grant, sell, and quit-claim unto the said  
Ebenezer Cheeney his Heirs and Assigns, all my right, title, claim  
and demand, in and unto a certain piece of land situate & lying  
in the Westerly part of said Barre and is a piece of land that John  
than Allen late of Barre dec'd died possessed of, and bounded  
as follows viz, on the County road leading from Barre to Petersham  
at a corner on the town road leading to Simpson Emes, thence  
on said County road to land of Ebenezer Cheeney, thence North-  
easterly on land of said Cheeney and others to land of Simpson  
Emes thence Easterly on said Emes' land to said town road,  
thence Westerly on said road to the first mentioned bound,  
estimated at thirteen acres more or less, reserving to myself  
all the wood standing and growing on said land and to be  
taken off in two years — excepting six trees which is to be left  
standing thereon — which is to be selected by said Cheeney. —  
To have and to hold the same to the said Ebenezer Cheeney his  
Heirs and Assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I  
do covenant to warrant and defend said granted and quit-claim-  
ed Premises, to the said Cheeney, his Heirs and Assigns forever, against  
the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by  
or under me. — In witness whereof, I the said Merriam Allen  
have hereunto set my hand and seal this thirtieth day of No-  
vember in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
