 acknowledge, do hereby grant, sell, and quit-claim unto the said
 Ebenezer Cheeney, his Heirs and Assigns, all my right, title, claim
 and demand, in and unto a certain piece of land situate & lying
 in the Westerly part of said Barre and is a piece of land that Iona-
 than Allen late of Barre dec^d died possessed of, and bounded
 as follows viz, on the county road leading from Barre to Petersham
 at a corner on the town road leading to Simpson Emes', thence
 on said county road to land of Ebenezer Cheeney, thence North-
 erly on land of said Cheeney and others to land of Simpson
 Emes' thence Easterly on said Emes' land to said town road,
 thence Westerly on said road to the first mentioned bounds,
