edge, do hereby give, grant, sell and Convey unto the said Simon
Bicknell a certain piece or tract of land situate or lying in the
Easterly part of Mendon aforesaid, containing eight acres eleven
rods be the same more or less, with all the privileges & appurtenances
thereunto belonging, bounded & bounded as follows, viz; beginning at
the Easterly corner of the piece, being at the Northerly corner of
Jotham Howard's pasture, thence Northerly & bounding Easterly on
the road that leads from Penniman's store to Providence forty two rods,
thence S 83 1/4 W. twenty six rods twenty links, thence S 1 1/4 E forty five
rods fifteen links to Jotham Howard's land, the two last lines bound
Northerly & Westerly on the Grantor's land, thence S 73 1/3 E. one rod
ten links, thence N 80° E eighteen rods, thence N 72 1/4 E. ten rods four
