I know all men by these presents, that I at rial Cook of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts Yeoman in consideration of twenty two dollars paid me by Olney Cook of the same Mendon Painter the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Olney Cook his heirs & assigns a certain tract or piece of land situate in the Easterly part of Mendon aforesaid containing one acre & nineteen rods, with all the privileges & appertenances thereto belonging, bounded & bounded as follows viz beginning at a stake & stones at the southerly corner of the piece it being on the Northerly side of the road that leads from my dwelling house to Alvin Allens thence N. 44½° W. eight rods to stakes & stones thence N. 45½° E. twenty one rods to a stakes & stones, thence S. 44½° E ten rods, sixteen links to stakes & stones at the road aforesaid. These three lines bounds westerly, Northerly, and Easterly on the grantors other lands; thence south westerly and bounding southeasterly on the
