Daniels Tyler Know all men by these presents that I, Tyler Daniels of Worcester in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
to  
Olney Cook  
Yeoman in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars paid by Olney Cook of Mendon in the County of Worcester Painter  
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant sell and convey into the said Olney Cook his heirs and assigns forever, a certain piece or tract of wood and pasture land,  
situated and lying in said Mendon, containing twenty four acres and Eighty six rods, and is bounded as followz, viz,  
beginning at the northeast corner of the premises at the corner of a wall on the south side of the Turnpike leading from Boston to Hart ford, thence running north  $52^{\circ}$  west six by one and an half rods to the northeast corner of Jonathan Russell's land and bounding northerly on the said Turnpike road,  
thence south  $5\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  west thirty five rods; thence south  $6\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  east eighteen rods, thence south  $2\frac{1}{3}^{\circ}$  west thirty three and three fourths of a rod to a stake and stones, and bounding westerly on land belonging to said Russell, Daniels Thurber and Caleb N. Allen; thence south  $90\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  west seventeen rods to a stump on a large rock; thence south  $49^{\circ}$  east fifty one rods to Atrial Cook's land; thence north, on said Cook's land  $19\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$  east, seventy and half rods; thence north,  $20\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  east nineteen
