Bullard Mary      I know all men by these presents that I Mary Bullard of Mendon  
 in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts  
 Lewis Boyden widow in consideration of two hundred and seventy five dollars  
 paid by Lewis Boyden of the same Mendon tinsmith maker the  
 receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant  
 sell and convey unto the said Lewis Boyden his heirs and assigns  
 a certain piece of land situated in said Mendon on the northwesterly  
 side of Boston and Hartford turnpike road containing by es-  
 timation about one acre be the same more or less with all the  
 buildings thereon standing, and is bounded southerly by said  
 turnpike road northerly by Robert Allen's lands and westerly  
 on a town road and is the same premises that I bought of Timothy  
 Rockwood & Nathaniel Johnson Executors of the last will and  
 testament of Josephus Wheaton late of Holliston deceased  
 as conveyed to me by their deed dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March  
 A. D. 1826 with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto  
 belonging - To have and to hold the aforesigned premises  
 to the said Lewis Boyden his heirs and assigns to his and  
 their use and behoof forever. And I do for myself my heirs  
 executors and administrators covenant with the said Lewis  
 Boyden his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seised  
 in fee of the aforesigned premises that they are free of all in-  
 cumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same  
 to the said Lewis Boyden and that I will warrant and defend the same  
 premises to the said Lewis Boyden his heirs and assigns for-  
 ever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

 set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of February  
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
