premises to the said Timothy Ellis his heirs and assigns forever against  
the lawful claims and demands of all persons - In witness whereof I  
the said Lewis Boyden and Melatiah Boyden wife of the said Lewis in  
token of quitting my right of dower or thirds in the premises have here-  
unto set our hands and seals this twelfth day of June in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine -

in consideration of Three hundred and thirty two dollars to me paid by  
Isaac Southgate, Joshua Lamb, Dwight Bisco and Joseph A. Denny all of  
said Leicester - cardmakers and copartners under the firm of Isaac South-  
gate & Co. - the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give grant  
sell and convey unto the said Isaac Southgate, Joshua Lamb, Dwight Bisco,  
Joseph A. Denny their heirs and assigns the following described lot of  
pasture & woodland situated in the northwesterly part of said Leicester  
bounded and described as follows vizt beginning on the road which lead  
by Golva Greens dwelling house, at the southwest angle of a woodlot now  
owned by the grantees & thence running by said road south 39° West  
thirty seven rods - thence south 50° East by land of John Marsh thirty four  
rods thence North 63° East by land of said Marsh fifty two rods and a  
half - thence North 15° West by land of the present grantor eight rods and  
four links to the corner of land of Billings Hobart & the present grantee  
thence by said woodlot of the grantees North 69° West fifty rods and a half  
to the place of beginning - containing in all twelve acres and one hundred  
& twenty four square rods - being the southwesterly part of a tract of land  
recently conveyed to me by deed of William Sprague -
