wife of him the said Robert Allen in testimony of quitting my right of dower
in said premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this seventeenth
day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirty —

of me the subscriber on the ninth day of November last past in consider-
ation of three thousand five hundred dollars paid him Stephen Lewitt
of Bellingham in our County of Norfolk, yeoman, & Samuel Allen of Mem-
don in the County of Worcester, Esquire, by his deed of that date did give and
sell & convey unto the said Lewitt & Allen their heirs and assigns forever
all the farm on which he now lives situate in said Memdon with all
the privileges thereunto belonging containing one hundred & eighty three
acres more or less for a particular description of which reference being
had to said deed from said Alvan Allen to said Lewitt & Allen recorded
in the Registry of Deeds at Worcester in said County of Worcester on
the 10th day of May 1829 Book 271 Page 68. — To have and to hold
the same premises to the said Lewitt & Allen & their and their heirs and
assigns to their use and behoof forever, and covenanting with the said
Lewitt & Allen their heirs and assigns that he was lawfully desited in fee
of the aforesigned premises that they were free of all incumbrances - that
