sideration of Two hundred and twenty five dollars paid by Joshua Mellen &  
David P. Mann both of Westboro and County and State aforesaid, yeomen, the  
receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell and convey  
unto the said Joshua Mellen and David P. Mann a certain lot of swamp land  
lying in the Southeastly part of the said Westborough aforesaid and bounded as  
follows, viz; beginning at a stake on the river at the northwesterly corner by  
land supposed to belong to James Warren, thence S. 4<sup>th</sup> E. 87 rods to a cedar tree  
marked to a point; thence North 20<sup>th</sup> E. 50 rods & 23 links to a stake by land  
of Joshua N. Mellen; thence N. 6<sup>th</sup> E. 40 rods by land of Thomas Morse to a stake  
at the river; thence on the river N. 87<sup>th</sup> W. 17 rods & 12 links; thence on said river S.  
67<sup>th</sup> W. 11 rods & 4 links to the bound first named, containing nine acres one quarter  
and twenty one rods by measure ——— To have and to hold the afore granted  
premises, to the said Joshua Mellen & David P. Mann their heirs and assigns,  
to them their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said Joshua  
Mellen & David P. Mann their heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee
