seventy one dollars¹² paid me by Rebecca Bates of the
same Mendon scummatress the receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge do hereby give grant sell and convey unto the
said Rebecca Bates her heirs and assigns a certain tract of
pasture land situated in the easterly part of Mendon aforesaid
containing eighteen acres eighty nine rods with all the
privileges & appurtenances belonging therewith butler bounded as
follows viz beginning at the northeasterly corner of the prem at
a corner of wall it being at the northwesterly corner of Simon
Bishness land thence $S 84^{\circ} W 69$ rods thence $S 79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 17$ rods 8 links
thence $S 16^{\circ} N 20$ rods 15 links to heap of stones at Jotham Howard
land the threelast lines bound, northerly & westerly on the granors other
land thence $S 79\frac{1}{3}^{\circ} E 94$ rods to said Bishness land bounding
southerly on said Howard land thence $N 13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 45$ rods 15 links
to the first mentioned bound bounding easterly on said Bishness
