 of the river road thence north 67° west 10 rods to a corner of a wall
 and fence on Day & Baldwin's land thence on said Day & Bald
 wins land north 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ East 11 rods to a stake and stones a corner of
 said Goldsmith's lot thence south 70° East 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ rods on said
 Goldsmith's lot to place of beginning with all the privileges and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging containing three fourths acre be the
 same more or less To have and to hold the aforesigned prem
 ises to the said Hale his heirs and assigns to their use and behoof
 forever And I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators
