edge do give grant sell and convey unto the said John Davis his heirs  
and assigns all that certain real estate with the privileges and appurte  
nances situate in Worcester aforesaid bounded beginning at a point  
on the northerly side of Williams Street one hundred feet easterly of land  
conveyed by said Messenger to John Mooney thence on said Williams Street  
easterly to land conveyed by said Messenger to John B. Clark by deed re  
corded Book 406 Page 77 thence on said Clark's land northerly to land  
of John Green thence on said Green's land westerly to other land of said  
Messenger being a point one hundred feet easterly of said Mooney's land  
thence on said other land of said Messenger to the point of beginning  
with the right of passing and repassing on and over Williams Street  
and using the same as an open and public way forever.  
To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said John Davis his heirs  
and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever And I do for myself my heirs  
executors and administrators covenant with the said John Davis his heirs  
and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesigned premises

convey the same to the said John Davis and that I will warrant and  
defend the same premises to the said John Davis his heirs and assigns
