Carlton Augustus Garrison all men by these presents that I Augustus Carlton of Sutton County
of Worcester and commonwealth of Massachusetts Farmer in consideration
of one hundred and fifty dollars paid by Joseph Dudley of Sutton aforesaid
County and State the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do give grant
sell and convey unto the said Joseph Dudley his heirs and assigns a cer-
tain tract of land situated in Sutton aforesaid County and State lying on
the Central Turnpike so called on the South side of the road in the corner
of two roads East of Judson Day's, beginning at the corner South of said
road and running East about twenty rods as the wall now stands to an
other wall then South about twenty rods to another wall thence West about
eight rods to the road which passes by the East end of Judson Day's house.
The East line bounded on Royal Penniman's land and the South line
on the Widow Dens land containing about two acre be the same more
or less. — To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said
Joseph Dudley his heirs and assigns to them and their use and behoof for
ever and I do for myself my heirs executors and administrators concurred
with the said Joseph Dudley his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully so in-
titled in fee of the aforesigned premises that they are free of all incumbrances
and that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said
Joseph Dudley and that I will warrant and defend the same premises
to the said Joseph Dudley heirs and assigns for ever against the lawful claims
and demands of all persons. — Provided nevertheless that if the said
Augustus Carlton heirs executors or administrators pay to the said Joseph
Dudley his heirs executors administrators or assigns the sum of one hun-
dred and fifty dollars and interest in two months from this date then this
deed as also a certain note bearing even date with these presents given by
the said Augustus Carlton to the said Joseph Dudley to pay the same sum
of one hundred and fifty dollars at the time aforesaid shall both be void
otherwise shall remain in full force and virtue. — In witness whereof
