Know all men by these presents that I Clark Cook 2<sup>d</sup> of Mendon in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth of Massachusetts promiss in consideration of the sum of thirty three Dollars & fifty cents to me paid by Olney Cook of the same Mendon County the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge do hereby grant sell and quite claim unto the said Olney Cook his heirs & assigns all my right title claim and demand in and unto a certain tract or parcel of land situated in Milford in said County on the North side of the old turnpike road containing twelve acres & thirty six rods more or less bounded South only on said road Easterly on land of the Mrs of Alan Allen deceased: North only & Westerly partly on said Mrs Allen & partly on land of Jedediah Bates the M<sup>r</sup> Kellys however otherwise the same may be bounded or reputed to be bounded being one of the tracts of land that my Grand Father Stephen deceased devised to my Brothers & sisters & myself and is all my ninth part in the premises I have and to hold the same to the said Olney Cook his heirs and assigns forever to his & their use & behoof forever  
 In witness whereof I the said Clark Cook 2<sup>d</sup> have here unto set my hand and seal this tenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty eight
