Hayward, of said Mendon, in said County, widow, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do give, grant, sell, and convey unto the said Mary M. Hayward, the following described piece of real estate, situated in said Mendon, with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging; containing eleven acres, more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: Beginning at the North easterly corner on the Southeasterly side of the road leading from the late residence of Warren Rawson, deceased, to the dwelling house of Salmon Wood, thence running Easterly bounding Northerly by land of Amariah Tabt to land of Nahum Gaskill; thence by land of said Gaskill, twenty three rods, to an old wall; thence thence turning and running Westerly on said wall fifty four rods to stake and stones at the end of the wall; thence still Westerly thirty four rods and eleven links to the said road, bounding Southerly on said Robbins other land; thence running Northerly, bounding Northwesterly on said road, fifteen rods and eleven links to the point of beginning. Meaning hereby to convey the same piece of land conveyed to me by Lewis F. Gardner, my brother.

To have and to hold the above

granted premises, to the said Mary M. Hayward, her heirs and assigns, to her & their use and behoof forever. And I do for myself, my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant with the said Mary M. Hayward, her heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the afore-granted premises; that they are free of all incumbrances, excepting a mortgage given by my brother ^{said} Lewis F. Gardner, to David Davenport, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Mary M. Hayward; and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Mary M. Hayward, her heirs and assigns, forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, the mortgage as aforesaid.
