To have and to hold the afore granted premises to the said John B. Mellen his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And we do for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said John B. Mellen his heirs and assigns that we are lawfully seized in fee of the afore granted premises that they are free of all incumbrances that we have good right to sell and convey the same to the said John B. Mellen and that we will and our heirs shall warrant and defend the same premises to the said John B. Mellen his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

And I Isabella Turner wife of the said Balvin Turner for the consideration aforesaid do hereby release and quitclaim unto the said John B. Mellen his heirs and assigns all the right title claim or demand which I may have in and unto the premises hereby conveyed under or by virtue of the homestead exemption laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and also all right claim or possibility of dower in said premises.
