1857, & recorded in the Worcester Registry of Deeds
Book 51B Page 618 & 657. And also the undivided
half part of all the rights and privileges conveyed
to Eggers, Carlton & Co. by deed of David H. Warren
dated the thirtieth day of August A.D. 1858,
and recorded in said Registry of Deeds Book 598
Page 595, to which deed reference is hereby had for
a more full description of said land, right and privi-
leges. The buildings on said premises are to be his
owned by said Baker for \$200. and made pay-
able to said S. H. Carlton in case of loss by fire.
To have and to hold the aforesaid premises
to the said Samuel H. Carlton his heirs and assigns,
to his and their use and behoof forever. And to be
