

land to a stake and stones about three feet West of an apple tree, thence in line with said Bosworth Easterly about twenty five feet to a stake and stones, thence Northwesterly about sixty feet on the line of land of John Banfill to the Springfield road aforesaid, thence on said road Westerly about sixty feet to the first mentioned bound.

To have and to hold the abovegranted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Inhabitants their heirs and assigne to them & their use and behoof forever. And I the said Samuel R. Burrough for ourselves and our heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Inhabitants of Warren their heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seised in fee simple of the aforegranted premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Inhabitants of Warren their heirs and assigne forever as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Inhabitants of Warren their heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

In witness whereof we the said Samuel R. Burroughs and Eliza S. Burroughs wife of the said Samuel R. Burroughs in token of her release of all right and title of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises have hereunto set our hands and seal this fourth day of December in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and sixty five.
