Staples his heirs and assigns to his and their use and behoof forever. And I the said Rachel S. Staples for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Carlton S. Staples his heirs and assigns that the premises are free from all incumbrances made or suffered by me and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Carlton S. Staples his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. In witness whereof I the said Rachel S.
