of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth  
of Massachusetts in consideration of one hundred and thirty  
eight dollars paid by Summer Ballou of said Mendon the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant,  
bargain sell and convey unto the said Summer Ballou his  
heirs and assigns, a certain tract of land situated in said  
Mendon upon the Easterly side of the road leading from the  
house of Gustavus W. Williams to the road leading from  
Mendon to Plybridge by the Unitarian Meeting House, and is  
bounded as follows viz: Beginning at a point on said first  
mentioned road at a corner of Joanna Sinsley's land, it  
being the Northwest corner of the premises, thence on said road  
S. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. three rods sixteen links to a stake in the ground  
being a corner of land this day deeded by grantor to Bath  
Taft thence N. 67 $\frac{1}{4}$  E. eight rods two links to Charles  
A. Child's land stake and stones, thence on said Child's land  
N. 21 $\frac{1}{4}$  W. five rods eight links to Anna Hastings' land  
thence on said Hastings' and Joanna Sinsley's land S. 55 $\frac{3}{4}$   
W. nine rods eight links to the point of beginning, contain-  
ing forty one and one half square rods. To have  
and to hold the above granted premises with all the privi-  
leges and appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said  
Summer Ballou his heirs and assigns to their use and  
behoof forever. And I the said Amy E. Taft for myself and  
my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with  
the said Summer Ballou, his heirs and assigns that I am  
lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforesigned premises  
that they are free from all incumbrances that I have good  
right to sell and convey the same to the said Summer Ballou,  
his heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid and that I will  
and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant  
and defend the same to the said Summer Ballou his heirs  
and assigns forever against the lawful claims and de-  
mands of all persons.
