

in the ground, thence Easterly one hundred and twenty five feet to a stone set in the ground, thence South Easterly thirty feet to a stone set in the ground, thence Easterly eighty four feet to a stone set in the ground, thence Northerly one hundred and forty five feet to a stone set in the ground, thence Westerly one hundred and fifty three feet to a stone set in the ground at the south east corner of barnyard, thence on barnyard wall forty five feet to the point of beginning. To have and to hold the above granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Tucker her heirs and assigns to their use and behoof forever. And I the said Southwick for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Tucker her heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the afore granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Tucker her heirs and assigns forever as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Catherine Tucker her heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.

Southwick wife of said Andre, in token of her release of all right and title of or to both dower and homestead in the granted premises have hereunto set our hands and seals this seventh day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and eighty two.
