I, now all men by these presents that I

to Albert E. D. Gardner of Providence in the State of Rhode Island in consideration of nine hundred and fifty dollars paid by Henry M. Darling of Watertown in the County of Jefferson and State of New York the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Henry M. Darling his heirs and assigns two certain tracts or parcels of land with all the buildings thereon standing situate in Mendon County and State aforesaid lying on the East side of the road leading from the dwelling house of the late Nathan George by and past that of Gilbert Gaskill and described in two certain deeds the one given by Thomas Gardner to Adam Wheelock dated the twenty fifth day of June A.D. 1841 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds Book 369 Page 153 the other given by Leonard Leaver and Cynthia P. Leaver to the said Adam Wheelock dated the twenty first day of March A.D. 1839 and recorded in the Registry of Deeds Book 339 Page 459 to which reference may be had for a more particular description and the boundaries thereof except about eleven acres sold and conveyed to Lewis H. Gardner the fourteenth day of June A.D. 1845.

To have and to hold the

granted premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry M. Darling and his heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever. And I do hereby for myself and my heirs executors and administrators covenant with the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the granted premises that they are free from all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Grantee and his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
