 with the buildings thereon and all the privileges and appurtenan-
 ces thereto belonging situated on the Easterly side of Lyon Street in
 said Worcester, bounded and described as follows to wit: Beginning
 on the Easterly side of Lyon Street, at a point forty feet distant
 Southerly from the point of intersection of the Easterly line of Lyon
 Street with the Southerly line of Bates Street, thence running Easter-
 ly and parallel with Bates Street eighty feet; thence turning and
 running Southerly and parallel with Lyon Street, forty feet; thence
 turning and running Westerly and parallel with the first describ-
 ed line and forty feet distant therefrom, eighty feet to said Lyon Street
 thence running and running Northerly toward Lyon Street forty
 feet to the place of beginning. To have and to hold the
