edged, do hereby give, grant bargain, sell and convey unto the
said Lyman E. Wheeler, his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or
parcel of land, situated in said Mendon, bounded as follows: Be-
ginning at the Southwesterly corner at a stake & stones, on the East-
