 Page 613. do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto  
 the said Isaac D. Goulding and his heirs and assigns  
 forever all that lot of land in Worcester aforesaid, on the  
 South side of Cambridge street, and on the West side of  
 Camp street, which was conveyed to me by Hannah Power  
 by her deed dated April 1. 1882. and recorded in the Regis-  
 try of Deeds for said County, Book 1117. Page 231. Being the  
 same premises conveyed by me to Worcester Mechanics Sav-  
 ings Bank, by mortgage deed recorded in said Registry of  
 Deeds, Book 1119. Page 517. To have and to hold the  
 granted premises to the said Isaac D. Goulding and his  
 heirs and assigns to their own use and behoof forever.  
 And I the grantor for myself and my heirs, executors  
 and administrators do covenant with the grantee and  
 his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in

 ting thirteen hundred and ten dollars, that I have good
