And it is agreed that the grantee, or its successors or assigns, or any person or persons in their behalf, may purchase at any sale made as aforesaid, and that no other purchaser shall be answerable for the application of the purchase money; and that, until default in the performance of the condition of this deed, I and my heirs and assigns may hold and enjoy the granted premises, and receive the rents and profits thereof. And for the consideration aforesaid I, Charles A. Wright, husband of the said Sarah M. Wright, do hereby release unto the said grantee, and its successors and assigns, all right of or to both courtesy and Homestead in the granted premises.
