Know all men by these presents that we, Frank B. Marsh of Mendon, in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and Celestina D. Marsh, wife of the said Frank B. in my own right, in consideration of Eleven Hundred and eighty Dollars paid by William P. Greenwood of Cambridge in the County of Middlesex and Commonwealth aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said William P. Greenwood, two certain tracts or parcels of land with the buildings thereon, situate and lying in Mendon aforesaid, and further described as follows, to wit: The first of said parcels is situate on the Easterly side of the road leading from South Milford to Bellingham and contains one half acre of land more or less and bounded as follows: Beginning at the northwesterly corner of the premises at the southwesterly corner of land now or formerly of Joseph Bates: thence Easterly by said Bates' land about fifteen and one half (15½) rods to the corner of a wall: thence Southerly by said Bates' land five and one half (5½) rods more or less to land formerly of Benjamin Bignall: thence by said Bignall's land as the fence stood fifteen and one half (15½) rods to said road: thence Northerly by said Road five and one half (5½) rods more or less to the point of beginning.
