Rawson of Northbridge in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations paid by Rupert F. Bates of Hopdale in said County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Rupert F. Bates, three several parcels of land with the buildings thereon, all situated in the Westerly part of Mendon in said County, and described as follows, namely: The first parcel being the same premises conveyed in the deed of Caleb Mowrey to Samuel Bills, dated March 11, 1814, and recorded with Worcester District Deeds Book 194, Page 635, and containing 45 acres 72 rods, more or less.
