Know all men by these presents that I, Norman F. Tucker of the City and County of Worcester, and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, in consideration of Eight hundred (\$800) Dollars paid by David B. Lovell of said City of Worcester, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said David B. Lovell a certain tract or parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situate on Pleasant Street in said Worcester and bounded as follows. Beginning at a point on the Northeastly side of said Street at corner of land conveyed to my wife Mary P. Tucker by deed of George Ryan in April 1899, recorded with Worcester District Deeds libro 1611 folio 61, being at a point distant by said Street line Northwesterly sixty four (64) feet from corner of land of Samuel D. Waite; thence running Northeastly by land of said Mary P. Tucker one hundred and fifty (150) feet to other land of grantor; thence Northwesterly by other land of grantor and parallel with said Street fifty six (56) feet to other land of grantor; thence Southwesterly by other land of grantor one hundred and fifty (150) feet to Pleasant Street; thence Southeastly by said Street sixty four (64) feet to point of beginning; being a portion of the same premises conveyed to me by deed of Charles M.
