Dresser; thence Southwesterly about 2 1/2 feet, to an iron pin  
in the ground; thence Northeasterly 60 feet to an iron pin in  
the ground; thence Northwestealy about 2 1/2 feet to an iron  
pin in the ground on the line of said highway; thence  
on the line of said highway 60 feet to the point of beginning.  
The first three courses are by land of Hon. Eben S. Stevens,  
formerly owned by Sylvester Dresser. See record of deed to
