Entwistle, of said Mendon, with W A R R A N T Y covenants a certain parcel of land including all buildings thereon, on the southerly side of the road leading from said Mendon to Milford, known as George Street, in said MENDON, bounded and follows, to wit:- Northerly by said George Street; easterly by land now or formerly of Moses U. Gaskill; southerly by land now or formerly of Moses U. Gaskill; and westerly by land of Ralph H. Gaskill, as the fence now stands. Being a part of the premises described in deed of Newman H.
