

and running nearly easterly by land now or formerly of L. Emerson, to the highway; thence running northwesterly, westerly and northwesterly by said highway to the point of beginning.

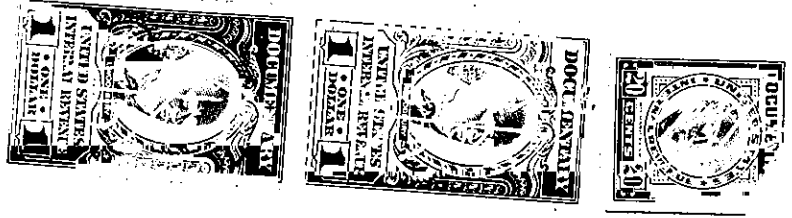
Also a certain other parcel of land with the buildings thereon, situated in said Mendon opposite the above-described parcel and bounded as follows:

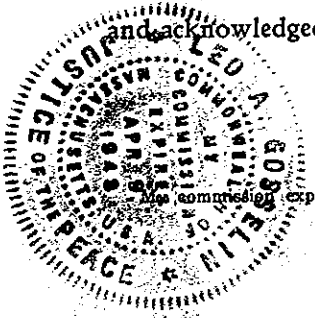
