situated on the easterly side of Elm Street in Mendon, in said County,

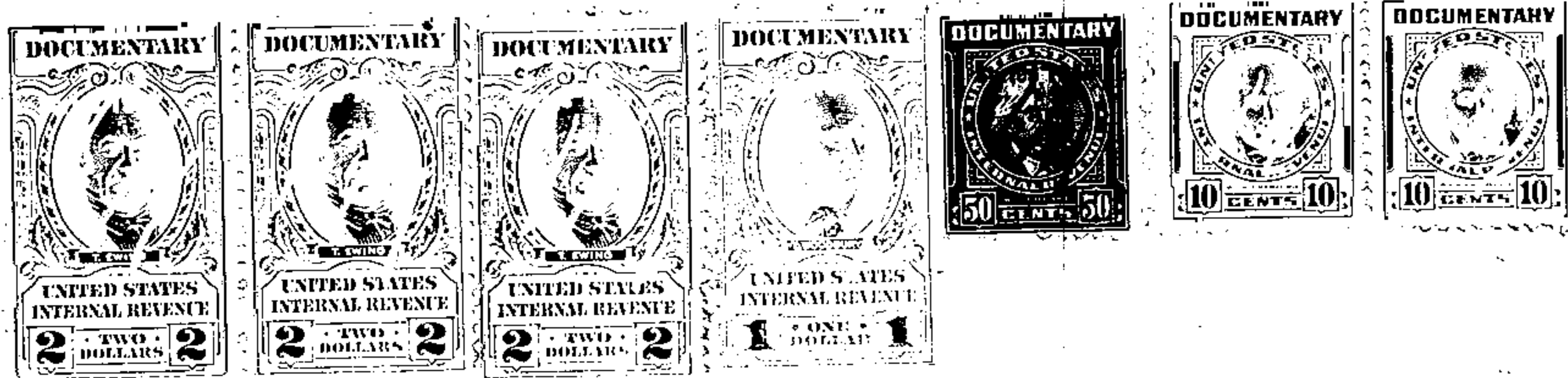

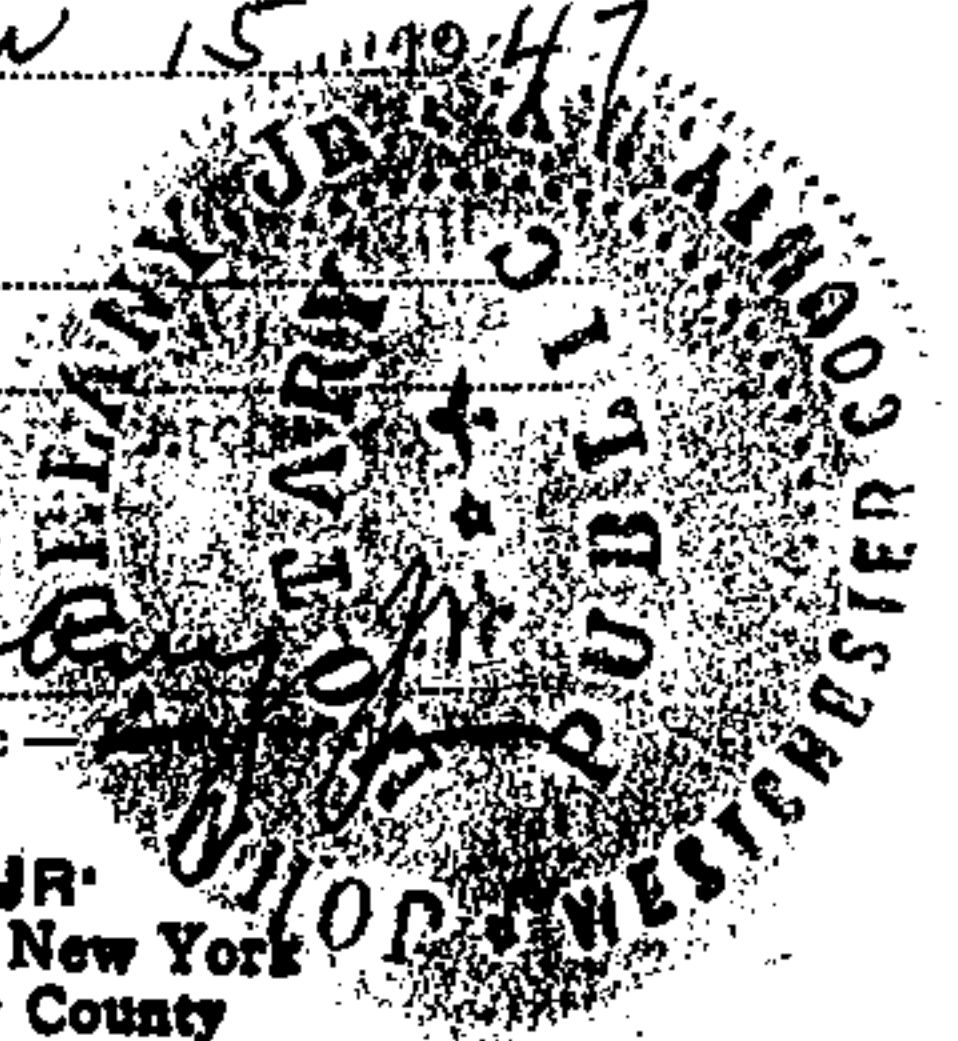
