THENCE- northerly by remaining land of these grantors, two hundred (200) feet, more or less, to the center of a stone bound;

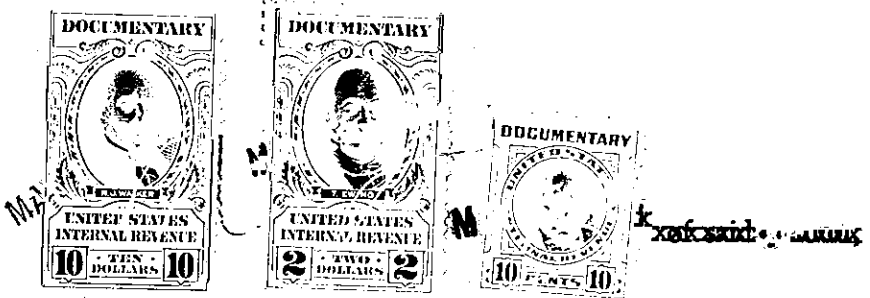
THENCE- westerly still by remaining land of these grantors two hundred (200) feet to the easterly side of said Blackstone Street;
