I give and bequeath to My daughter Mary B. Leathes wife of F. J. Leathes Fourteen Hundred Dollars, in Money.

Item 6

I give and bequeath all My household & kitchen furniture of every name and nature not named in My bequests, to My children S. P. Bates, Mary B. Leathes, Elias S. Bates H. S. Bates, and Lewis Bates to be divided among them Equally as they may agree among themselves, and any surplus of Money that may remain after paying the legacies heretofore granted.

Item 7

My out-lying lands are given to My son Elias S. Bates Henry S. Bates and Lewis, on this Condition, that if there shall not be money enough to pay debts and legacies, these lands shall be subject to any such deficiency and shall be sold or disposed of to pay the same.

Likewise I make Constitute and appoint My son Samuel P. Bates and Joseph S. Mapey to be the executors of this My last Will and Testament, revoking all former wills by me made. And I request My executors to divide and deliver the property as above bequeathed without any appraisal or sale. And I desire My children to accept the same without fault finding.
