 presents remain release and forever quitclaim unto the said

 interest whether in remainder or reversion or of what
 other name or nature soever in and to the land together
 with the Buildings thereon devised to the said Oti⁵⁹⁹ by the
 last will and testament of my Hon^d Father aforesaid to wit
 all and singular the land and buildings which were ori-
 ginally my Hon^d Grand Father Ichabod Ammidon de^d;
 Also ~~and~~ the land my Hon^d Father purchased of Simeon
 Staples lying on the Eastern side of the road leading by the
 premises bounded southerly by land given me by my Hon^d
 Father as Staples old south line end to run Easterly to
 Luke Aldrichs land thence northerly by said Luke Aldrichs
 and George Aldrichs land until it come to the land of my
 Hon^d Grand Father and Father purchased of John Sayls
 formerly old Capt. Rawson land so called thence westerly as
 the wall now stands by the said Rawson land to the County
 road leading from Worcester to Providence thence by said
 road to the first bounder together with all the remainder of
 the ^{wood} land lying at the pond hill (so called) bounded southerly
 partly on the pond and partly on Stephen Johnsons land
 westerly partly on a Town road and partly by Edward
