I know all men by these presents that I Otis

wealth of Massachusetts Gentleman in consideration of three
hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by Jonathan Russell
of Providence in the County of Providence & State of Rhode
Island & Providence Plantations Gentleman the receipt
whereof I do hereby acknowledge had & received and
forever quitclaimed and do for myself my heirs by these
presents remain released and forever quitclaimed unto the said
Jonathan Russell his heirs and assigns all the right title and
interest whether in possession remainder or reversion or to the land
together with the buildings and appurtenances thereto
belonging Devised by the last will and testament of my Hon.
Brother Philip Ammidon late of Mendon deceased to my
Hon^r Mother Lydia Ammidon which at any time since
the decease of my said Father was in or belonged to my Bro-
ther Philip Ammidon of Boston in the County of Suffolk
& State of Massachusettts aforesaid Merchant and convey'd
released & quitclaimed to me by my said Brother before died
bearing date the eighth day of June past bounded as
follows (to west) southerly by the road leading by said pre-
mises easterly by land of Seth Hastings Esq^r northerly by
land of Seth Davenport now improved by Thomas Staples
westerly by land of Joseph Tap and partly by land now improved
by Solomon Johnson to the aforesaid road together with the
wood land and pasture land my Hon^r Father purchased of
Simon Staples and John Ballard lying on both sides of the
turnpike road at the pond hills (so called) Also one other
piece of land with a Stove thereon lying on the South side
of the road leading by said premises on the west side of the
Providence road (so called) Bounded Easterly by said Providence
road northerly by the first mentioned road westerly by land
of John Otis and southerly by said hills & Dan Aldrich's land
