 State of Massachusetts Gentleman in consideration of  
 three hundred and twenty dollars to me paid by Jonathan  
 Russell of Providence in the County of Providence & State  
 of Rhode Island & Providence Plantations Gentleman the receipt  
 whereof I do hereby acknowledge have remised released and  
 forever quitclaimed and do for my self and my heirs by these  
 presents remise release and forever quitclaim unto the said  
 Jonathan Russell his heirs and assigns all my right title  
 and interest whether in possession remainder or reversion in  
 or to the land together with the building & appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging devised by the last will and testament  
 of my Hon<sup>d</sup> Father Philip Ammidon late of Mendon deceased  
 to my Hon<sup>d</sup> Mother Sylvia Ammidon bounded as follows  
 (to wit) southerly by the road leading by said premises East-  
 erty by land of Seth Hastings Esq<sup>r</sup> northerly by land of Seth  
 Davenport now improved by Thomas Staples westerly by  
 land of Joseph Fox and partly by land now improved by  
 Solomon Johnson to the aforesaid road together with the  
 wood land and pasture land my Hon<sup>d</sup> Father purchased  
 of Simon Staples and John Ballard lying on both sides  
 of the turnpike road at the pond hills (so called) Also one  
 other piece of land with a store thereon lying on the  
 south side of the road leading by said premises and on  
 the west side of the Providence road so called bounded  
 easterly by said Providence road northerly by the first
