Provided nevertheless that if the said John Whitmore his heirs Executors or Administrators pay to the said Nathan Bryant & William Pierce their heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the sum of four hundred and sixty two dollars and thirty six cents with interest (viz) two hundred & eighty dollars with interest according to said John Whitmores Note and Jesse Whitmores given to said Bryant dated December 29th A.D. 1804 promising said Bryant to pay him or his order the above said sum on demand with interest and to the said Pierce one hundred & eighty two dollars & thirty six cents with interest according to said John Whitmore Note given to said W^m Pierce dated August 25th A.D. 1808 promising said Pierce to pay him or his order the said sum on demand with interest then this deed as also two certain Notes as abovesaid bearing date as abovesaid given by the said Whitmore to the said Nathan Bryant & William Pierce separately as abovesaid to pay them the same sums at the time aforesaid shall be void otherwise shall remain in full force - In witness whereof I the said John Whitmore have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight

Know all Men by these presents that Sylvia Amnidon of Providence in the County of Providence & State of Rhode Island & Providence Plantations in consideration of three hundred Dollars to me paid by John Miller of Mendon in the County of Worcester & State of Massachusetts if or when the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have received released & forever quit claimed & do for myself & my heirs by these presents remise release & forever quit claim unto the said John Miller his heirs & assigns all my right title and interest whether in possession or remainder or reversion in or to the land together with the buildings and appurtenances thereto belonging divided to me by the last Will and Testament of my beloved Husband Philip Amnidon of Mendon aforesaid lying & being in said town of Mendon bounded as follows to wit. southerly by the road leading by said premises easterly by land of Seth Hastings Esquire northerly by land of Seth Caversport now improved by Thomas Staples westerly by land of Joseph Fox easterly by land now improved by Solomon Johnson to the aforesaid road together with the wood land & pasture land my said beloved husband purchased of Simon Staples & John Ballard lying on both sides of the Purpise road at the pond hills so called - Also one other piece of land with a stone thereon lying on the south side of the road leading by the first described premises & on the west side of the Providence road
