Know all Men by these presents, that I Levi Rawson of Mendon in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Yeoman, in consideration of one Dollar paid me by Marren Rawson of said Mendon, to wit, the Receipt whereof, I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell & convey unto the said Marren Rawson, his heirs and assigns, a certain piece of land situated upon the West side of the first Parish meeting house in said Mendon, being the North end of the piece of land that said piece bought of the Parish on the West side of the road and is where said Marren's Office now stands and is to begin on the Road thence for 100 yds from the South end of the Office, and to extend Westward to the wall by Hastings and Davenport's land, and is to comprehend all the land north of said line reserving however to myself, during my natural life, one half of the Apples that may grow on the Apples standing thereon. - To have and to hold the same to the said Marren, his heirs and assigns to his and their heirs forever - and I do covenant with the said Marren, his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises, that they are free of all incumbrances, & that I will warrant and defend the same to the said Marren his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. - In Witness whereof, I the said Levi Rawson, and I Nancy Rawson Wife of the said Levi, in testimony of relinquishing my right of Power to said premises have hereunto set our hands and seals, this twenty second day of April A.D. 1812.

Know all Men by these presents that I Gamaniel Whitney of Minchendon, in the County of Worcester, Yeoman, in consideration of the sum of nine hundred & eighty Dollars paid to me by Samuel Johnson of Lunenburg in said County, Yeoman, the receipt whereof, I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, sell & convey unto the said Samuel Johnson and his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land situated in the Northern part of Minchendon aforesaid, to wit, being the Southern part of lot number one hundred and eight bounding south on the line which was formerly Minchendon line. That on land belonging now to me but formerly to James Robt. North on land now owned by Asaph Brown, containing one hundred acres by measure with a dwelling house thereon, to wit, being the same land buildings & hold by a deed from Nathan Knight together with the new house built on the premises. - To have and to hold the same to him the said Samuel Johnson & his heirs and assigns to his and their heirs forever - and I do covenant with the said Samuel Johnson and his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises, that they are free of all incumbrances, and that I will warrant and defend the same to him the said Samuel Johnson and his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. - In Witness whereof, I the said Gamaniel Whitney and Azubah Whitney Wife of the said Gamaniel have hereunto set our hands and seals in token of her giving up her right of Power and power of thirds in the premises unto the said Samuel Johnson, this fifteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred.
