Know all men by these presents that Johnon Johnson
of Leominster in the County of Worcester & Commonwealth
of Massachusetts Enquire in consideration of seventy dollars
paid me by Abijah Bigelow of the same Leominster Esq. or
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge do hereby give
grant full and convey unto the said Abijah Bigelow his
heirs and assigns a certain tract of woodland situated in Leo-
minster aforesaid containing five acres and one hundred
and forty rods by the same more or less, and lies about
a quarter of a mile south of the meeting house in said
Leominster bounded beginning at the corner of Kendalls land
and Thomas Lincolns land at a black oak tree and runs
on land of said Lincoln West thirty nine degrees North nine
and a half rod to a stake and stones thence partly over
land belonging to the heirs of Rebecca Johnson and partly
on land of Jacob Scallan South twenty degrees West twenty
eight rods to a stake and stones thence South thirty three
degrees East twelve rods on land of said Bigelow to a stake
and stones thence forty four rods by land of Benjamin
Johnson and Stephen Johnson to a pitch pine tree at the
corner of Kendalls land thence North twenty one degrees
West sixty five rods by said Kendalls land to the first mention
ed bound with all the privileges and appurtenances there-
to belonging —

To have and to hold the same to the said
Abijah Bigelow his heirs and assigns to him and them and
their successors forever and I do covenant with the said Abijah
Bigelow his heirs and assigns that I am lawfully seized in
fee of the premises that they are free of all incumbrances
and that I will warrant and defend the same to the said
Abijah Bigelow his heirs and assigns forever against other
lawful claims and demands of all persons. In witness
whereof I the said Asa Johnson have hereunto set my hand &
seal this Thirteenth day of June in the year of our Lord Eighty
Eight hundred and fourteen — Asa Johnson *(initials)*
