 to Paxton in the County of Worcester and Commonwealth of Massachu  
 Moses Maynard } setts Yeoman, in consideration of thirteen hundred dollars paid by  
 Moses Maynard of Marlborough in the County of Middlesex and Common  
 wealth aforesaid Yeoman, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do here  
 by give, grant, sell and convey unto the said Moses Maynard, and his heirs &  
 assigns, a certain tract of land with the buildings thereon standing, sit  
 uate in the Northwesterly part of said Paxton, bounded Northerly by land  
 of James Blair and Seth Metcalf, Westerly by lands of David Davis Jun<sup>r</sup>  
 Ebenezer Chamberlain, Adonijah Bartlett, & David Pierce, Southerly by  
 land of John Brigham, John Howe Jun<sup>r</sup>, the said Thaddeus Estabrook  
 and James Blair, and Easterly by Turkey Hill pond, socalled, reserving a  
 four rod Road through the premises; Also a meadow lot situate on the  
 Westerly side of said road; both pieces containing one hundred and five  
 acres, be the same more or less, The last mentioned piece is bounded North  
 erly and Westerly by land of John Howe Jun<sup>r</sup>, Southerly by land of Mar  
 maduke Earl, and Easterly by the aforementioned road.

To have and to hold the aforesigned premises to the said Moses May  
 nard and his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoef forever. And I  
 do covenant with the said Moses Maynard, and his heirs and assigns, that I  
 am lawfully seised in fee of the aforesigned premises, that they are free of  
 all incumbrances, that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the  
 said Moses Maynard; and that I will warrant and defend the same prem  
 ises to the said Moses Maynard, and his heirs, and assigns forever against the  
 lawful claims and demands of all persons.

 of dower in and to the aforesigned premises, have hereunto set our hands
