 assigns that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises that  
 they are free of all incumbrances that I have good right to sell and  
 convey the same to the said Hiltedge Hill and that I will warrant  
 and defend the same premises to the said Hiltedge Hill his heirs and  
 assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons  
 excepting hereby reserving the amount of three hundred Mortgages  
 one made by Silas Potter to the Boston Bank and two made by  
 me to Dwight Foster and are all duly Recorded in Worcester in said  
 County and also a life Lease made by me to Silas Potter all  
 which are understood by Hiltedge Hill to be in full force —

Provided nevertheless that if the said Nahum Potter his heirs  
 Executors or Administrators pay to the said Hiltedge Hill his  
 heirs Executors Administrators or assigns the sum of two hundred and  
 sixteen dollars on demand with interest then this Deed as also one cer-  
 tain note of hand bearing even date with these presents given by  
 the said Nahum Potter to the said Hiltedge Hill to pay the same  
 sum in money aforesaid at the time aforesaid shall all be void  
 otherwise shall remain in full force Elizabeth Potter present wife  
 of the said Nahum hereby gives up her right of dower in said prem-  
 ises — In witness whereof the said Nahum Potter and Elizabeth  
 Potter have hereunto set our hands and seals this twenty eighth day of  
 April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 twenty one —
