14 Sell and convey unto the said Amariah Taft about twenty acres of land with a dwelling house and barn standing on the same and lying in the northerly part of Mendon aforesaid bounding westerly on the County road leading from Mendon town to Worcester northerly and easterly on Seth Davenport's land and southerly on Doct. Alexander Thayers land with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging to have and to hold the afore granted premises to the said Amariah Taft his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do covenant with the said Amariah Taft his heirs and assigns, That I am lawfully seized in fee of the afore granted premises; That they are free of all incumbrances; That I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said Amariah Taft. and that I will warrant and defend the same premises to the said Amariah Taft his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. Provided nevertheless, that if the said John Fisher his heirs, Executors, or administrators, pay to the said Amariah Taft his heirs, Executors, Administrators or assigns, the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars in one year from the date hereof with Interest then this deed, as also a certain note bearing even date with these presents, given by the said John Fisher to the said Amariah Taft to pay the same sum with Interest at the time aforesaid, shall both be void; otherwise shall remain in full force. In witness whereof, I the said John Fisher have hereunto set my hand and seal this nineteenth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two.
