a acknowledge, do hereby grant, sell, and quit claim unto & 15 the said William S Hastings his heirs and assigns all my right, title, claim and demands, in and unto a certain piece or tract of land, situate in said Mendon, on the west side of the road leading from Providence to Worcester, and containing Eight rods and twelve feet, and bounded as follows, to wit, beginning at said road, near an Elm tree and running Westerly so as to touch the north side of said tree four rods, thence turning and running southerly two rods and three feet, thence turning and running Easterly four rods to said road thence turning and running northerly along the said road two rods and three feet to the bounds first mentioned, together with the brick building standing on the premises, which is now occupied by the Grantee as an office - To have and to hold the same to the said William S Hastings his heirs and assigns, to his and their use and behoof forever. And I do, covenant to warrant and defende said granted and quit claimed premises, to the said William S. Hastings his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claimed by, or under me.
